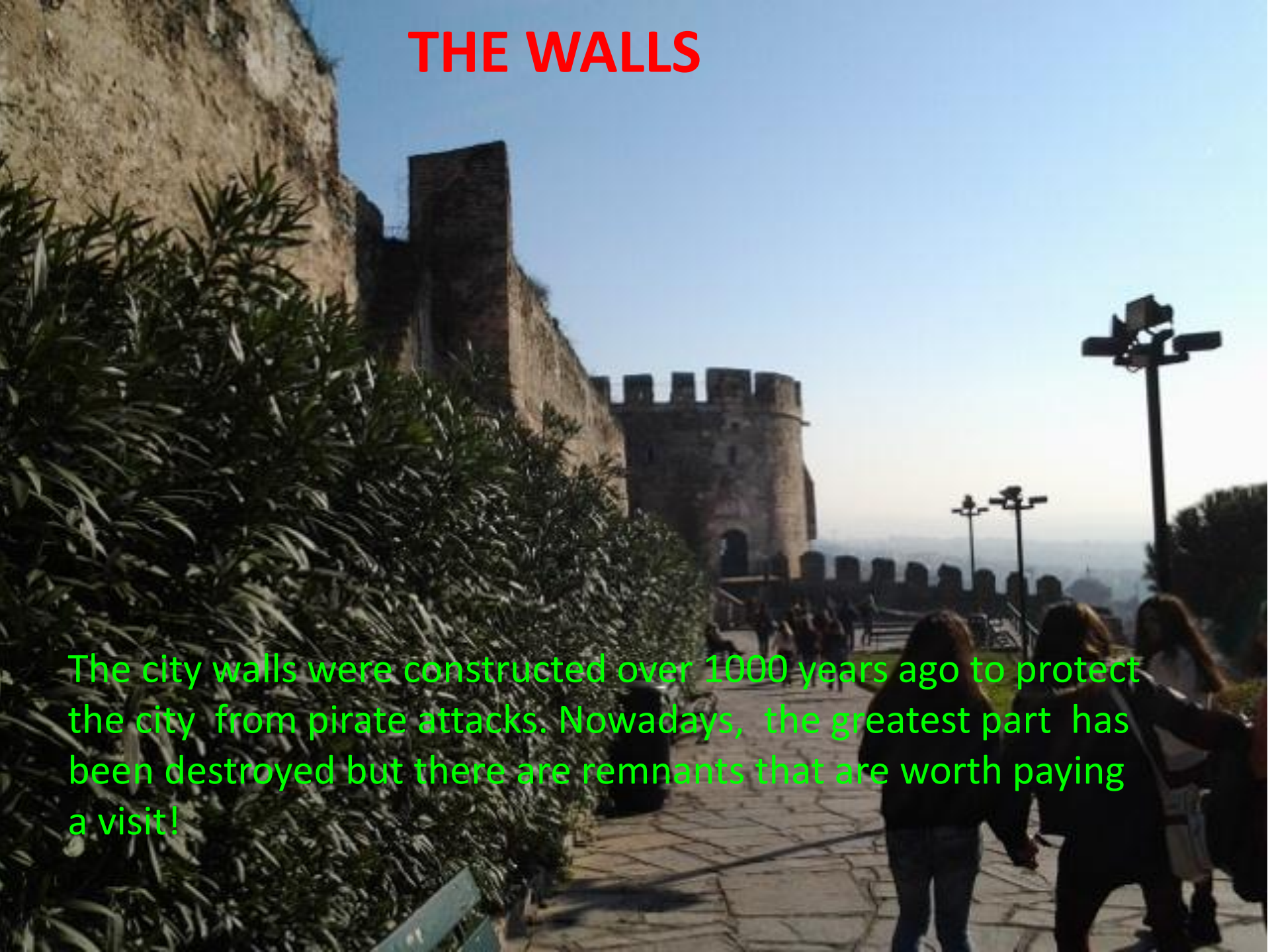
ANCIENT RUINS
